**Note** The drug giving rise to the adverse effect should be identified by use of codes from categories T36-T50 with fifth or sixth character 5.

**Code** Adverse effects, the nature of the adverse effect such as:

**First** Adverse effect NOS (T88.7)  
Aspirin gastritis (K29. -)  
Blood disorders (D56 - D76)  
Contact dermatitis (L23 - L25)  
Dermatitis due to substances taken internally (L27. -)  
Nephropathy (N14.0 - N14.2)

**Use additional codes to specify:**

Manifestations of poisoning  
Underdosing or failure in dosage during medical and surgical care (Y63.6, Y63.8 - . Y63.9)  
Underdosing of medication regimen (Z91.2-, Z91.13 -)

T36	Poisoning by, adverse effect of and underdosing of systemic antibiotics
T37	Poisoning by, adverse effect of and underdosing of other systemic anti-infectives and antiparasitics
T38	Poisoning by, adverse effect of and underdosing of hormones and their synthetic substitutes and antagonists, not elsewhere classified

### ICD-10 Made Simple - DOCUMENT!

**Acuity** Acute, chronic, intermittent

**Severity** Mild, moderate, severe

**Etiology** Trauma, diabetes, renal failure, exercise or infection induced

**Location** Where is it- be specific about which joint, chest, femur, posterior thorax

**Laterality** Which side is it? Left, right, both

**Detail** Present on admission status, associated symptom (hypoxia, loss of consciousness), additional medical diagnoses, initial versus subsequent encounter
