

## CONGENITAL CYSTIC KIDNEY DISEASE

*The following are important documentation tips and strategies for this disease/condition as required by the specificity needed in ICD-10:*

- Delineate between congenital versus acquired kidney cysts.
- List polycystic kidney disease as adult or infantile type.
- Indicate when the infantile type has collecting duct dilatation.
- Differentiate a congenital renal cyst versus a medullary cystic kidney.
- Detail if one or multiple cysts are present.
- Identify renal dysplasia and other cystic kidney Disease such as fibrocystic kidneys and Meckel-Gruber syndrome when applicable.
