

## CONGENITAL MALFORMATIONS OF GENITAL ORGANS

*The following are important documentation tips and strategies for this disease/condition as required by the specificity needed in ICD-10:*

- Identify with or without obstruction when detailing double reproductive organs (e.g., double uterus, cervix & vagina).
- Specify unilateral or bilateral for undescended or ectopic testis.
- Identify undescended testicles as abdominal or ectopic perineal when applicable.
- Detail the type of hypospadias:
  - *Balanic.*
  - *Penile.*
  - *Penoscrotal.*
  - *Perineal.*
  - *Congenital chordee.*
- List any syndromes associated with malformations according to the specific numerical and/or structural abnormality (e.g., Trisomy 18, polyploidy, Angelman syndrome, etc.).
