

DERMATITIS DUE TO INGESTED SUBSTANCES

The following are important documentation tips and strategies for this disease/condition as required by the specificity needed in ICD-10:

- Clarify whether the reaction is due to a substance, medication, or food.
- Describe the skin eruption as generalized or localized.
- List the substance that is causing the reaction.
- Detail the intention and circumstances surrounding the substance ingestion (e.g., accidental, intentional, malfunction of an insulin pump, wrong drug given to patient, etc.).
