

GENERAL PREGNANCY, CHILDBIRTH AND THE PUERPERIUM

The following are important documentation tips and strategies for this disease/condition as required by the specificity needed in ICD-10:

- Specify the type of prolapse (e.g., urethrocele, cystocele, rectocele, uterovaginal, vaginal enterocele).
- Clarify when uterus prolapse is accompanied by a cystocele, rectocele, enterocele, or urethrocele.
- List midline or lateral cystocele.
- Differentiate incomplete (first and second degree) And complete (third degree) uterine prolapse.
- Indicate when a prolapse of the vaginal vault occurs after a hysterectomy.
- Report any urinary or fecal incontinence.
- Provide information regarding any incomplete or weakening of pubocervical or rectovaginal tissue.
