

## GLOMERULAR DISEASES

*The following are important documentation tips and strategies for this disease/condition as required by the specificity needed in ICD-10:*

- Specify when nephritic syndrome is acute, chronic, or rapidly progressive.
- Provide information regarding hereditary nephropathy.
- Identify when hematuria is recurrent and/or persistent.
- State when isolated proteinuria is associated with a morphological lesion.
- Detail any of the following:
  - *Minor glomerular abnormality.*
  - *Focal and segmental glomerular lesions.*
  - *Dense deposit disease.*
  - *Glomerulonephritis.*
  - *Differentiate between diffuse membranous, mesangial proliferative, mesangiocapillary, endocapillary proliferative, and crescentic.*
- List any underlying disease (e.g., chronic prostatitis).
