



MENSTRUATION, ABNORMAL VAGINAL BLEEDING

The following are important documentation tips and strategies for this disease/condition as required by the specificity needed in ICD-10:

- Identify the specific type of abnormality.
- State if amenorrhea or oligomenorrhea is primary or secondary.
- Clarify if excessive and frequent menstruation occurs with regular cycles, irregular cycles, at puberty, or in the premenopausal period.
- Provide details when bleeding occurs with ovulation or post coital.
