OTITIS EXTERNAL

The following are important documentation tips and strategies for this disease/condition as required by the specificity needed in ICD-10:

- Specify the acuity (i.e., acute or chronic).
- Differentiate between infective and noninfective.
 - Detail infective as being diffuse, hemorrhagic,
 - or swimmer's ear.
 - List noninfective as being actinic, chemical, contact,
 - eczematoid, or reactive.
- Provide information regarding any underlying disease (e.g., candidiasis, impetigo, gout, etc.).
- Indicate any associated perforated tympanic membrane.
- State any related tobacco use, abuse, dependence, past history, or smoke exposure (e.g., second hand, occupational, etc.).
- Identify laterality (i.e., right, left, or bilateral).
