



## **SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS RELATED TO GENITOURINARY SYSTEM**

*The following are important documentation tips and strategies for this disease/condition as required by the specificity needed in ICD-10:*

- Clarify the significance of associated conditions and signs and symptoms (e.g., dysuria, urinary incontinence, overactive bladder, etc.).
- Indicate when signs and symptoms point to a specific diagnosis (e.g., frequency due to acute cystitis).
- Specific urinary symptoms associated with benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH) (e.g., nocturia, hesitancy, retention, weak stream, etc.).
- Identify signs and symptoms that are not routinely associated with or integral to a disease process.
