

# ICD-10 Education



The US Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has mandated the replacement of the ICD-9 system of codes with the ICD-10 system on October 1, 2015. Two key components of ICD-10 include increased specificity in clinical documentation, and amplified levels of knowledge for coding and support staff. To address our educational needs, the Scripps ICD-10 team, in tandem with the Center for Learning and Innovation (CFLI), are preparing to support our organization through a menu of options tailored to the needs of various audiences.
