



Configuring patient data sharing within medical group affiliations

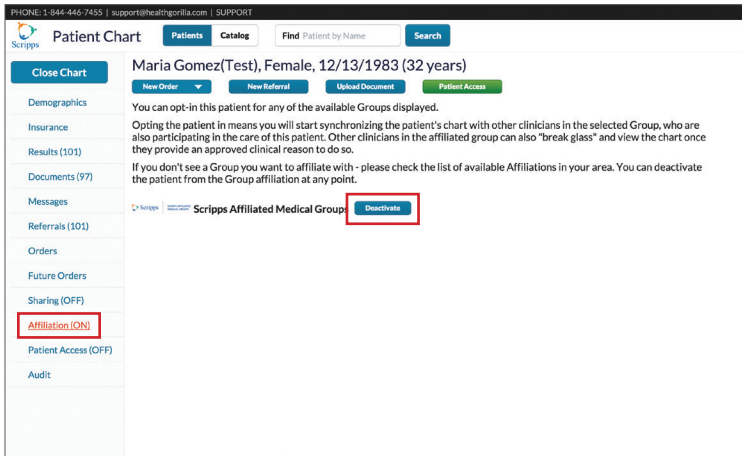

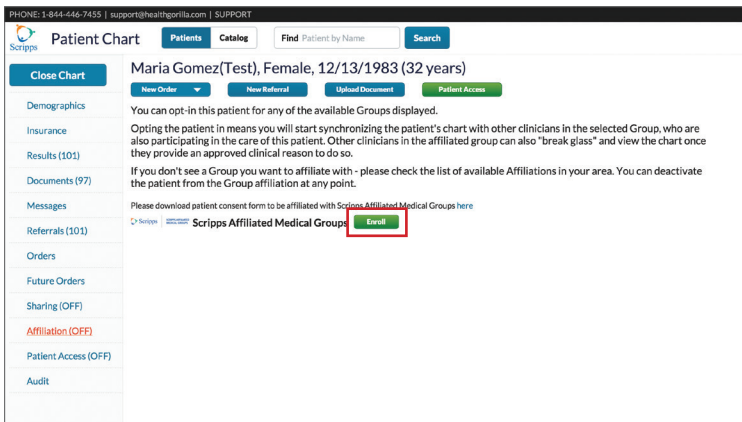
Clinical Connect by Health Gorilla allows physician practices to enroll into medical groups, by establishing an affiliation. By virtue of being affiliated with a group like IPA, ACO or a Foundation (or a combination of these), the physician's practice can view and exchange enrolled patients' data with other providers affiliated with the same group.

While it is possible to view and exchange the data within the affiliated medical group, each patient's Universal Chart in Clinical Connect must be enabled for the data exchange.

To identify patient's current affiliation enrollment status please login to Clinical Connect and look up the patient chart. Once in the patient chart - click the Affiliation menu on the left.



If the patient has already been enrolled for the data sharing within this group - the Affiliation Menu will display (ON) indicator. In order to deactivate the data sharing for this patient within the displayed group, click **Deactivate** button next to the group's name.



Otherwise, if the patient has not been enrolled, you can enroll the patient into data sharing by clicking **Enroll** button.
