

Scripps ACO Achieves Qualifying APM Participant Status

Based on the first snapshot period of January 1 through March 31, 2017 the Scripps ACO and participating providers have achieved Qualifying Provider (QP) status. As you recall, CMS designates QP status by individual physician (NPI) based on a calculation using the entire population of our Advanced APM ACO. This means that Scripps ACO physicians are considered QPs in an Advanced APM for performance year 2017 and are therefore excluded from the MIPS quality reporting program and will receive the 5% lump sum Medicare incentive payment from CMS in 2019.
